RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING A COUNTY-WIDE MASS TRANSIT SYSTEM FOR YUMA COUNTY AND WITH THE CITY OF YUMA ADMINISTERING THE SAME

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis is located in the County of Yuma and is a community which is growing at a rapid rate, and whereas said growth has shown the increased need for a mass transit system not only inside the City of San Luis but throughout the County of Yuma; and


WHEREAS, the City of Yuma is best able to lead in the development and administration of such a system; and


WHEREAS, the City of San Luis in furtherance of the above objectives would like to pledge a fair amount of support and resources as may be reasonably required to implement the foregoing.


