

RESOLUTION NO. 267

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, COMMITTING LOCAL FUNDS AS LEVERAGE FOR THE 1993 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis has adopted Resolution No. 255 which authorizes submission of an application to the State of Arizona, Department of Commerce for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the 1993 program year, and

WHEREAS, that application indicates that \$28,832 will be committed by the City of San Luis as leverage funds, in the form of city crew, materials, administrative staff; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG program requires that all local leveraged funds or resources be committed in the form of a resolution by the governing body, and that such a commitment contains an opinion by the applicant's legal counsel that the leveraged funds represent a binding commitment, legally enforceable under State laws,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, hereby commit \$28,832 to the 1993 CDBG program, to be used for the following activities:

contingent upon the receipt of the Fiscal Year 1993 CDBG assistance; and that the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, hereby state that this commitment is legally binding based on the legal opinion of the City Attorney, and that such funds or resources will be available for an audit at the termination of the grant, if so required by the Arizona Department of Commerce.


