

RESOLUTION NO. 294

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA SUPPORTING WESTERN ARIZONA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS DESIGNATION AS AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration is authorized to create regional Economic Development Districts; and

WHEREAS, these Economic Development Districts are designated to provide a regional approach in addressing income and employment problems; and

WHEREAS, the governor of each state must request the U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration, to designate the region as an Economic Development District; and

WHEREAS, the U. S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration, provides planning grants to Economic Development Districts to identify and maintain an inventory of the region's infrastructure and demographic characteristics, and to develop strategies for improving the economy in the region.




