A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA, URGING THE LEGISLATURE TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS AND INFRASTRUCTURE FOR THE BORDER CITIES THAT WILL BE IMPACTED BY THE N.A.F.T.A. PROGRAM.

WHEREAS; The City Council of San Luis Arizona, will be forced to comply with all requirements related to traffic control and transportation and

WHEREAS; The City of San Luis will be greatly impacted by the increase in vehicle and pedestrian traffic and

WHEREAS; The City lacks the necessary traffic control devices and pedestrian walks to insure the safety and welfare of it's citizens.


