A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, APPROVING THE DESIGNATION OF THE ACTING CITY MANAGER JENNY TORRES AND FIRE CHIEF ANGEL RAMIREZ AS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY AND MILITARY AFFAIRS; REPEALING CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona:

Section 1: The San Luis City Council designates Acting City Manager Jenny Torres and Fire Chief Angel Ramirez as Authorized Representatives to request the Governor's Emergency Funds through the State of Arizona, Department of Emergency and Military Affairs, Division of Emergency Management, as required under Title 26 of the Arizona Revised Statutes and the Arizona Administrative Code §§ R8-2-301 and R8-2-302.

Section 2: Their designation as Authorized Representatives allows them to request time extensions and attend to other recovery matters related to a specific Governor-Declared Emergency.

Section 3: The City officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.


Section 4: If a conflict arises between the provisions of this Resolution and any other ordinance, resolution, order, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are amended, superseded, and replaced, and this Resolution shall govern.

Section 5: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence clause, phrase, or portion of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction or controlling legislation, such decision or law shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Resolution.




