
A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, TO ENTER INTO A JOINDER AGREEMENT WITH THE ARIZONA PUBLIC SAFETY PERSONNEL RETIREMENT SYSTEM ON BEHALF OF THE FULL-TIME, PAID MUNICIPAL FIRE FIGHTERS REGULARLY ASSIGNED TO HAZARDOUS DUTY OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, Arizona, did on the 22nd day of March, 1995, pass a resolution authorizing an actuarial survey to be made to determine the estimated cost of participation in the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System, and


WHEREAS, the preliminary actuarial survey has been made and it has been deemed in the best interest of the City of San Luis, Arizona, to include all full-time, paid municipal fire fighters who are regularly assigned to hazardous duty under the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System Act as set forth in Title 38, Chapter 5, Article 4, Arizona Revised Statutes as amended 1988;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, that the Mayor of the City of San Luis, Arizona, be authorized to sign a Joinder Agreement with the Arizona Public Safety Personnel Retirement System Fund Manager.


