

**RESOLUTION NO. 314**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A APPLICATION FOR PATENT OF 28.12 ACRES OF LAND TO THE BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT.**

**WHEREAS,** The City of San Luis desires to apply for patent of 28.12 acre lands to the Bureau of Land Management; and

**WHEREAS,** said lands owned by the Bureau of Land Management are located at Township 11 South, Range 25 West, Gila & Salt River Meridian, Sec. 1, S1/2NW1/4SE1/4SW1/4, S1/2NE1/4SW1/4SW1/4, E1/2NW1/4SE1/4SW1/4SW1/4, E1/2SE1/4SW1/4SW1/4, SW1/4SE1/4SW1/4, and that portion of the SE1/4NW1/4SW1/4SW1/4 and of the W1/2NW1/4SE1/4SW1/4SW1/4 lying east of the centerline of the U.S. Highway 95, and;

**WHEREAS,** The City of San Luis has substantially developed these lands for Recreation and Public Purposes; and

**WHEREAS,** The City wishes to own the said property and is willing to purchase said property under terms of special pricing program BLM Manual 2741-71(C) from Bureau of Land Management.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it resolved that the City Council of the City of San Luis does hereby request the Bureau of Land Management to patent said 28.12 acre of lands to the City of San Luis for Recreation and Public Purpose.
