

RESOLUTION NO. 323

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN APPLICATION FOR 40 ACRES OF LAND TO THE BUREAU OF RECLAMATION.

WHEREAS, The City of San Luis desires to apply for 40 acre lands to the Bureau of Reclamation; and


WHEREAS, Said lands owned by the Bureau of Reclamation are located at Township 11 South, Range 24 West, Gila & Salt River Basin Meridian, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Luis wishes to develop the land for the dedicated purpose of a City operated Cemetery.

WHEREAS, The City wishes to apply for the said property for Public Purpose and is willing to manage said property under terms from Bureau of Reclamation.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of San Luis does hereby request the Bureau of Reclamation to patent said 40 acre of lands to the City of San Luis for Public Purpose.
