

RESOLUTION NO. 325

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, PROVIDING NOTICE OF THE REGULAR PRIMARY ELECTION; ESTABLISHING POLLING PLACES AND VOTING DISTRICTS AND THE TIMES THAT SUCH POLLS WILL BE OPEN; AND ADOPTING ELECTION OFFICIALS AND FIXING THEIR COMPENSATION.

WHEREAS, it is provided by law for the holding of a Primary Election; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have by resolution called a Primary Election to be held March 12, 1996.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, as follows:

Section 1. Designation of Election Date

That the City Primary Election be held on Tuesday, March 12, 1996, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the offices of three (3) Councilmember seats. That any candidate receiving a majority of all of the votes cast at the Primary Election will be declared elected without running at the General Municipal Election.

Section 2. Polling Places and Voting Districts

That City Hall, 23222 First Street, San Luis, AZ 85349, be designated as a polling place. The polls shall be open from 6:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Section 3. Election Officials and Their Compensation




