

**RESOLUTION NO. 328**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 12, 1996; AND ORDERING THE RECORDING OF SUCH RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, Yuma County, Arizona did cause to be submitted to the qualified electors of the City at a primary election held in and for the City on the 12th day of March, 1996 for the nomination of three Councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Yuma County, Arizona as follows:

Section 1. That the total number of ballots used at said primary election was 479.

Section 2. That the total number of rejected ballots at said primary election was 6.

Section 3. That the total number of spoiled ballots was 5.

Section 4. That the total number of valid ballots cast at said primary election as shown by the poll lists, was 468.

Section 5. That the votes cast for Councilmember are as follows:

Section 6. That Section 2-3-1 of the Code of the City of San Luis, Arizona, pursuant to authority granted from Arizona Revised Statute 9-821.01, provides that at a primary election a candidate who receives a majority of all valid votes cast shall be declared to be elected. That a majority of 468 votes is 235 votes, and that Carlos Bernal received a majority of valid votes cast.

Section 7. It has been determined that Pedro Julian was not a resident of the City of San Luis, AZ, for one year next preceding the Primary Election and is therefore ineligible to be a candidate for the General Election.






