RESOLUTION NO. 336

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, PROVIDING FOR THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE YOUTH TASK FORCE COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF SAN LUIS: PROVIDING FOR AND THE ELECTION OF A CHAIRMAN AND VICE CHAIRMAN THEREOF; PRESCRIBING GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES OF SAID COMMISSION.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Luis, County of Yuma, State of Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Youth Task Force Commission of the City of San Luis, Arizona, is hereby established.

SECTION 2. A. The Youth Task Force Commission of the City of San Luis shall be composed of members who may or may not be residents of the City of San Luis, the number of members to be determined by the council, and shall be appointed by the common council of the City of San Luis.

B. All members shall serve without pay.

SECTION 3. The Commission shall elect a Chairman and Vice Chairman from among its own members, who shall serve for one (1) year until their successors are elected and qualified. The chairman shall preside at all meetings and exercise all the usual rights, duties and prerogatives of the head of any similar organization. The Vice Chairman shall perform the duties of the Chairman in the latter's absence or disability.

SECTION 4. It shall be the duty of said Commission to formulate, create and administer any lawful plan adopted by the governing body for the present and future youth of the City of San Luis.

SECTION 5. the Commission shall provide for its meetings; provided however, that meetings may be called by the Chairman or in his absence the Vice Chairman. A majority of members shall constitute a quorum.


