A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR A
CERTIFICATE OF NECESSITY FOR AMBULANCE SERVICES
TO THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Luis is responsible for providing for the well being of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, having determined that the City of San Luis Fire Department has the ability to provide emergency ambulance transportation services; and

WHEREAS, such service will provide advanced cardiac life support and paramedic services on each and every emergency occurrence; and

WHEREAS, this service provides the opportunity to recover expenses of providing the existing emergency medical services of the City of San Luis Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, such services are in the best interest of the citizens of the City of San Luis.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of San Luis that City staff is authorized to submit an application to the Arizona Department of Health Services for the Certificate of Necessity to operate an emergency transport ambulance service within the corporate limits of the City of San Luis and take all necessary actions to complete procedural steps to obtain the Certificate of Necessity.




