**AUTHORIZING TO SUBMIT APPLICATION(S)
AND IMPLEMENT CDBG PROJECTS**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION(S) FOR FY 1997 STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS, CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATION(S) MEETS THE COMMUNITY'S PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of undertaking community development activities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is administering the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the State CDBG Program requires that CDBG funds requested address one of the three Congressional mandated National Objectives; and

WHEREAS, the activities within this application(s) address the community's identified housing and community development needs, including the needs of low and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, a grantee of State CDBG funds is required to comply with the program guidelines and Federal Statutes and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, authorize application to be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Commerce for FY 1997 CDBG funds, and authorize the Mayor to sign application and contract or grant documents for receipt and use of these funds for Library Expansion and Homeowner Assistance, and authorize the Mayor to take all actions necessary to implement and complete the activities submitted in said application(s); and


