RESOLUTION NO. 360

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, ESTABLISHING INTENT TO PARTICIPATE IN A YUMA/IMPERIAL COUNTY COMPACT CALLED THE RIO COLORADO CONSORTIUM FOR THE PURPOSES OF DEVELOPING A PARTNERSHIP TO EXPLORE AN APPLICATION FOR A FEDERAL EMPOWERMENT ZONE FOR YUMA/IMPERIAL COUNTY.

WHEREAS, Yuma County and Imperial County are neighbors divided only by the Colorado River; and,

WHEREAS, Yuma County and Imperial County are both rapidly developing entities facing similar challenges, needs and perspectives; and,

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, is located in Yuma County and would be an integral part of the strategic plan for designation of a Yuma/Imperial County Empowerment Zone; and,

WHEREAS, formal adoption of this resolution by the City of San Luis City Council is the first step towards the designation of the Rio Colorado Consortium Federal Empowerment Zone for Yuma/Imperial County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, this 23rd day of July, 1997.
