RESOLUTION NO. 366

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, DESIGNATING THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, AS A "COLONIA".

WHEREAS, a "Colonia" development as defined by the United States Department of Agriculture has occurred in the City of San Luis, and;


WHEREAS, communities which lack potable water supplies, adequate sewage systems, and/or decent, safe, and sanitary housing are eligible for designation as a "Colonia", and;

WHEREAS, designation as a "Colonia" is necessary before certain state and federal funds can be made available to improve infrastructure systems and housing within those communities and;


WHEREAS, all of the City of San Luis existed as a "Colonia" before December 28, 1989;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of San Luis, Arizona, is hereby designated as a "Colonia" because of the lack of adequate potable water supply, adequate sewage system, and/or decent, safe and sanitary housing.


