RESOLUTION NO. 368

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, REDUCING CERTAIN WATER RATES AND CHARGES, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THE REDUCTION OF SAID CHARGES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY WITH REASON THEREFOR

BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

WHEREAS, Article 11, Water System Administration, of the City Code of the City of San Luis recites in Section 11-2-1 that water rates and charges may be changed by the Council by resolution, and;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Common Council to reduce certain water rates and charges,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:


Section 1: That the current rate for residential use (meter size  $5/8 \times 3/4$ ) is \$12.50 for the first 3,000 gallons of use;

Section 2: That it is the desire and Council does hereby reduce said rate to \$7.95 for the first 2,000 gallons of use;

Section 3: That it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of San Luis, Arizona, an emergency is declared to exist, but that in order to facilitate orderly billing the effective date of this resolution shall be January 1, 1998.
