## A RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATION FOR A TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANT

WHEREAS, Housing America Corporation's mission is to provide decent, safe and sanitary housing for low income and very low income families of Yuma and Mohave Counties. Housing America Corporation will be applying for it's ninth (9th) consecutive grant since 1981, and;


WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is a severe shortage of decent housing for low and very low income families in Yuma County, and;


WHEREAS, the Housing America Corporation is interested in improving the housing situation for low and very low income residents in Yuma County, and;

WHEREAS, it is proposed by the Housing America Corporation to continue a program for the construction of the houses using the Mutual Self-Help Method, under which the Housing America Corporation will provide necessary technical assistance with funds that are available from Rural Development, U.S. Department of Agriculture (RD,USDA), under Section 523 of the 1949 Housing Act,


NOW, THEREFORE, be it known that the City of San Luis, Arizona, supports the efforts of Housing America Corporation to submit an application to Rural Development for a grant not to exceed \$900,000.00 to continue to develop a family housing project using the Mutual Self-Help Method within the county of Yuma. This grant will be used over a two year period to serve approximately 94 families in San Luis and Somerton, Arizona.
