RESOLUTION NO. 393

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF YMPO'S DEMAND-RESPONSE DIAL-A-RIDE TRANSIT PROJECT, UTILIZING THE CITY'S SHARE OF AZ HB 2565 LOCAL TRANSPORTATION FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis recognizes and participates in the Yuma Metropolitan Planning Organization (YMPO) as the regional transportation planning agency that acts on behalf of and for the benefit of regional transit planning within Yuma County, Arizona and the governmental entities within the County of Yuma, State of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis supports the YMPO's Demand-Response DIAL-A-RIDE Transit Project to provide demand-response transit services to the Greater Yuma Area; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis supports the 1999-2003 YMPO Transportation Improvement Program which includes the DIAL-A-RIDE Demand-Response Transit Project described above; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis desires that its AZ HB 2565 Local Transportation Fund monies for FY 1999 in the amount of \$14,535 are given to the YMPO with a YMPO match of \$3,634 for operation of the Greater Yuma Area DIAL-A-RIDE Transit Project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Luis, that it be known to the Arizona Department of Transportation, that the YMPO is authorized to act on the behalf of the City of San Luis, in the acceptance, use, and administration of the AZ HB 2565 funds for FY 1999.


