**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA ESTABLISHING INTENT
TO PARTICIPATE IN A FUNDING APPLICATION TO
THE NORTH AMERICAN DEVELOPMENT BANK FOR
THE PURPOSES OF STUDYING MUTUALLY BENEFICIAL
PARTNERSHIPS INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, REGIONAL
WATER AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES**

WHEREAS, Yuma County, City of Somerton, and the Cocopah Indian Tribe are neighbors in the Yuma area; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis is located in Yuma County; and

WHEREAS, the government entities in the Yuma area are facing similar challenges, needs and perspectives in providing water and wastewater services; and

WHEREAS, the North American Development Bank (NADBank) will provide funding for a feasibility study to examine regional water and wastewater facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Somerton, Yuma County Board of Supervisors, and the Cocopah Indian Tribe have passed and adopted resolutions establishing the intent to participate in a funding application to NADBank;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of San Luis City Council, hereby directs the City Manager to work cooperatively with government entities in the Yuma area to apply for NADBank funding of a feasibility study on regional water and wastewater facilities.
