**RESOLUTION NO. 418. A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING THE CONTINUATION OF A COUNTYWIDE ENTERPRISE ZONE; AUTHORIZING THE YUMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO CONTINUE ACTING AS THE ENTERPRISE ZONE COMMISSION; AND THE GREATER YUMA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (GYEDC) TO CONTINUE ACTING AS THE ENTERPRISE ZONE ADMINISTRATOR.**

**WHEREAS,** The State of Arizona has authorized the creation of Enterprise Zones to promote the creation of new or expanded businesses in economically distressed areas; and

**WHEREAS,** the continuation of an Enterprise Zone encourages the creation of new employment opportunities for the citizens of the County; and

**WHEREAS,** the reduction of unemployment and the establishment of new or expanded businesses contributes to the economic well-being of the City of San Luis, Yuma County and its citizens; and

**WHEREAS,** the Yuma County Board of Supervisors is the appropriate entity to act as the Enterprise Zone Commission; and

**WHEREAS,** the Greater Yuma Economic Development Corporation has the resources needed to act as the Enterprise Zone Administrator;


