WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, through the police department, is interested in submitting projects to be considered for funding in the form of reimbursable grants from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and the Federal Highway Administration.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the San Luis City Council as follows:


Section 1. THAT approval of the filing of projects for consideration in Arizona's year 2000 Highway Safety Plan is granted.


