## RESOLUTION NO. 436

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A RECREATION AND PUBLIC PURPOSE ACT AMMENDMENT FOR FRIENDSHIP PARK TO CREATE A SHOPPING CART RETAINING STRUCTURE.**

**WHEREAS,** The City of San Luis, Arizona, desires to amend the Recreation and Public Purpose patent as it pertains to Friendship Park outlined by the Bureau of Land Management; and

**WHEREAS,** said land to be adapted to create a shopping cart retaining structure is Lot #13, T11S, R25W Section 1 G&SRM; and


**WHEREAS,** The City of San Luis, Arizona, recognizes the need for a shopping cart retaining structure in Friendship Park for the safety and convenience of its citizens and visitors; and

**WHEREAS,** The City of San Luis, Arizona is willing to facilitate construction and maintenance of said cart retaining structure under the terms of the Bureau of Land Management Recreation and Public Purpose Act.



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

**THE CITY OF SAN LUIS WISHES TO PLACE A SHOPPING CART RETAINING STRUCTURE SIMILAR TO THOSE ONE WOULD FIND AT SUPERMARKETS AND SHOPPING CENTERS. THIS CART ACCESS AND DEPOSIT WOULD BE LOCATED ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE FRIENDSHIP PARK. THE CITY OF SAN LUIS WOULD CREATE A PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY BY CREATING A SIDEWALK ALONG THE EXISTING TREE LINE. ALSO, THE CITY OF SAN LUIS WOULD CREATE A NEW GATE IN THE EAST FENCE TO ALLOW PEDESTRIANS TO PLACE THEIR CARTS IN THE RETAINING STRUCTURE AND EXIT THE PARK. THE RETAINING STRUCTURE AND PEDESTRIAN ACCESS WOULD BE CLOSED THE SAME TIME AS THE PARK ITSELF IS CLOSED. THESE ALTERATIONS WOULD BE A PERMANENT CHANGE TO THE PARK.**

**THE PUBLIC WOULD BENEFIT FROM THIS CHANGE BECAUSE SHOPPERS WOULD HAVE A SAFER MEANS OF DEPOSITING CARTS BEFORE CROSSING THE BORDER TO MEXICO. ALSO, THE CUSTOMS OFFICES WOULD NOT HAVE TO DEAL WITH CARTS PARKED CLOSE TO THE BORDER, ELIMINATING A POTENTIAL TRAFFIC HAZARD. FURTHERMORE, THE PROJECT \$9,000 COST WOULD BE OFFSET BY THE GREATER ACCESSIBILITY TO DOWNTOWN MERCHANTS.**


**THIS CHANGE IN THE PARK WOULD IMPROVE THE STANDARD LIVING FOR THE CITIZENS OF MEXICO AND THE U.S.A BY ELIMINATING A SAFETY HAZZARD AND UNSIGHTLY AREA. ALSO, THE CITIZENS WOULD STILL HAVE A MEANS OF TRANSPORTING PURCHASES FROM DOWNTOWN STORES TO THE BORDER OF MEXICO.**
