## Resolution No. 446

A Resolution of the City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, authorizing the submission of an application on behalf of a non-eligible applicant for State Housing Funds (which may include federal funding through the HOME Investment Partnership Program or State Housing Funds), certifying that said application meets the community's housing and community development needs.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Luis is desirous of promoting affordable housing development activities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is administering the State Housing Fund Program; and

WHEREAS, the State Housing Fund requires that State Housing Funds benefit low income households; and


WHEREAS, the activity in the application addresses the community's low-income housing population needs; and


WHEREAS, if the application is successful, the project sponsor, Riedel Construction, Incorporated ("Sponsor"), a non-eligible applicant, will request that the State contract directly with the Sponsor for the project funding, thereby releasing the City from further involvement or liability relating to the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, authorizes application to be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Commerce, on behalf of the project Sponsor, for funding from the State Housing Fund, and authorizes Alex Joe Harper, Mayor, to sign the application and any documents necessary to facilitate the State contracting for the project funding directly with the Sponsor.
