RESOLUTION NO.463

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS REVISING THE DEFINITION OF "CLASSIFIED SERVICE" OF THE PERSONNEL RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, Arizona did duly adopt the current Personnel Rules & Regulations; and

WHEREAS, an updated policy is in the draft stages and being prepared to replace the current policy; and

WHEREAS, IT IS THE DESIRE OF THE council to amend the definition of "classified service".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follow:

Section 1. That RULE I. DEFINITION OF TERMS of the Personnel Rules & Regulations of the City of San Luis, SECTION 6. CLASSIFIED SERVICE, is hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced by the following:

SECTION 6. CLASSIFIED SERVICE: All positions of employment in the service of the City except the City Manager, Magistrate, Police Chief, Fire Chief, and City Attorney and those additional department heads that may be specifically excluded by City Council action.

Section 2. All other provisions of the Personnel Rules and Regulations not specifically amended hereby are reaffirmed in their entirety.
