RESOLUTION NO. 510

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, ACCEPTING THE "ACCESS CONTROL REPORT FOR THE YUMA AREA SERVICE HIGHWAY (SR 195) IN YUMA COUNTY."

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis has adopted and executed A.G. Contract No. K98 2562TRN, as amended, related to the establishment and development of the Yuma Area Service Highway (SR 195), a.k.a. ASH; and

WHEREAS, the Yuma Area Service Highway (SR 195) is to be established and developed as an access controlled freeway; and


WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has caused the preparation of the "Access Control Report for the Yuma Area Service Highway (SR 195) in Yuma County" to designate initial points of access to SR 195; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona desires that said Report be utilized as a guideline "to provide the local planning authorities with sufficient information to understand the access control provided to/from the ASH corridor and to allow planning of the land development along the cross streets that will not adversely impact the future operation of the ASH corridor."




