RESOLUTION NO. 530

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, CERTIFYING TO THE STATE TREASURER THE BASELINE COURT COLLECTIONS FOR EACH QUARTER OF FISCAL YEAR 2002-2003, AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURE FOR REPORTING ON A QUARTERLY BASIS THEREAFTER, TO THE STATE TREASURER THE AMOUNT COLLECTED ABOVE THE BASELINE COURT COLLECTIONS AT THE END OF EACH QUARTER AS REQUIRED BY ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES SECTION 12-116.04 AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Legislature enacted House Bill 2533 which was codified as Arizona Revised Statutes 12-116.04 for the purpose of requiring each city to certify to the State Treasurer baseline court collections, and

WHEREAS, A.R.S. 12-116.04(B) requires the City to report on a quarterly basis thereafter to the State Treasurer any amounts collected above the baseline court collections reported for fiscal year 2002-2003, and

WHEREAS, the statute requires the report to be certified to the State Treasurer within 15 days after the end of each quarter, therefore requiring that the City develop an expedited process for certifying such collections.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1: That for purposes of A.R.S. 12-116.04(A), the City Council does hereby certify to the State Treasurer the baseline court collections for each quarter of fiscal year 2002-2003 as shown in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.


SECTION 2: That as required by A.R.S. 12-116.04(B), a report of the amounts collected above the baseline court collections at the end of each quarter shall be provided within the time frame required in said statute to the City Council for purposes of certification to the State Treasurer. City staff is hereby authorized to implement a reporting process that will allow the City Council to certify the required court collection report to be submitted to the State Treasurer within the time frame provided in the statute. If necessary, City staff is authorized to transmit the report as required by the statute to the State Treasurer and have the report certified by the City Council by a Motion as soon as possible thereafter. The form for reporting the required court collections shall be essentially in the form shown in "Exhibit B", attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.


