**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Border Patrol is the designated agency for patrolling our borders with trained personnel; and

**WHEREAS**, vigilante groups patrolling our borders are a threat to the safety and well being of all citizens in Yuma County, Arizona; and


**WHEREAS**, many citizens in Yuma County, Arizona may be discriminated against solely due to the color of their skin; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis wish to express their opposition to either vigilante groups or individuals from taking the law into their own hands.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona hereby through this resolution propose that citizens of Yuma County join together in an effort to say NO to vigilante activities along our borders throughout Yuma County, Arizona and encourage all border cities, towns, and others, to do the same.


