A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, MAYOR AND COUNCIL RATIFYING COMMENTS IN SUPPORT OF THE U.S.GOVERNMENT SERVICES ADMINISTRATION'S PROPOSED DESIGN 6.3 FOR RECONFIGURATION OF SAN LUIS I PORT OF ENTRY.

**Whereas**, the Mayor and Council members recognize the need to reconfigure San Luis I to provide residents and visitors safe access to the United States and Mexico in the wake of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks; and

**Whereas**, the Mayor and Council members of the City of San Luis recognize the need to reconfigure San Luis I to compliment the construction of San Luis II, the future Commercial Port of Entry; and

**Whereas**, the Mayor and Council members recognize that a decision of "No Action" as defined in the 2004 San Luis I Feasibility Study will hinder the economic growth of the City; and

**Whereas**, the Mayor and Council members recognize the vital role that a reconfigured San Luis I Port of Entry will play in developing the City of San Luis's position in a global economy and furthering economic relationships with San Luis, Rio Colorado, Sonora, and the interior states of Mexico;

**Therefore, be it known** by all that the San Luis City Council does hereby provide the following comments in support of the future development of San Luis I.

With support from the U.S. Government Services Administration (GSA), the City of San Luis respectfully requests that the final San Luis I Port of Entry design recommendations:


- 1) Maintain and/or improve pedestrian and vehicular access to the HWY 95/Juan Sanchez Boulevard commercial corridor, City emergency services access to the Port of Entry, and access to "B", "C", and "D" Streets between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenues.
- 2) Assist in identifying a city transit system that allows for improved port access while improving existing port security.
- 3) Identify a course of action for discussions among the GSA, the Arizona State Land Department, and the San Luis Economic

Development Corporation to determine an equitable resolution concerning port expansion in the San Luis Industrial Park.


- 4) Allow for GSA assistance as the City works with the Bureau of Land Management to expand the parking facilities in Friendship Park to accommodate expected increases in pedestrian and vehicular traffic and a transit system in the port area.
- 5) Provide assistance in identifying and accessing federal and state transportation dollars to provide funding necessary for roadway improvements to and from the port of entry for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenues and the corresponding intersection and roadway connections.


