RESOLUTION NO. 565

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, COUNTY OF YUMA AUTHORIZING AND SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION TO THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR REGIONAL ECONOMIC PLANNING FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Commerce and Economic Development Commission (CEDC) at the Arizona Department of Commerce is statutorily tasked with the creation of a 10-year economic strategy for the state; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Commerce, through a Statewide Economic Study has identified eleven (11) economic structures or regions in the State; and

WHEREAS, the boundary of Yuma County has been designated as the South River region; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Commerce has announced the availability of economic planning funds for six (6) regions to undertake regional economic planning efforts; and

WHEREAS, these funds are to assist economic regions to better understand the economy of the region and to develop strategic plans that integrate community, workforce and business development functions and determine the direction of economic development activities for the next ten (10) years; and

WHEREAS, economic development partners in Yuma County have determined the need to conduct a baseline assessment and a gap analysis of foundational elements to further economic opportunities in south Yuma County; and

WHEREAS, the proposed study is eligible for economic planning funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of San Luis, Arizona, County of Yuma hereby wishes to acknowledge and authorize the Yuma Private Industry Council to submit an application to the Arizona Department of Commerce for the Regional Economic Planning Grant.


