A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING AND SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURAL RURAL DEVELOPMENT (USDA) BY BLUE MOON.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Luis, on August 25, 2004, acknowledges, the fact that Broadband (high-speed internet) availability is vital to the residences and business of our community and that there currently is no existing broadband service available to our residences and that there are federal funds available to assist in bringing Broadband services to rural communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, THAT:

The City of San Luis joins and support the Community Broadband Collaboration's effort to create a Community Broadband project to be built, owned and managed by Blue Moon Solutions, Inc. (Blue Moon), Blue Moon will apply for a Rural Utilities Services' Community-Oriented Connectivity Broadband Grant and the award of such grant will make the project possible.

The City of San Luis also agrees to provide IN-KIND grant match in the form of rental value for city owned building space to be renovated for a community technology center and rental value of city owned rooftop and tower access for antennas. This rental value is to be given to Blue Moon only for the period necessary to meet the required match amount. Any building space, rooftop, and tower access desired by Blue Moon after this time will be negotiated.

READ, CONSIDERED, PASSED AND APPROVED this 25th day of August, 2004 at a Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Luis at which a quorum was present and which was held in accordance with Chapter 551 of the Local Government Code. Signed this 25th day of August, 2004.
