RESOLUTION NO. 580

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT SUPPORTING THE RENEWAL AND CONTINUATION OF A COUNTY-WIDE ENTERPRISE ZONE WITH THE YUMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ACTING AS THE ENTERPRISE ZONE COMMISSION AND THE GREATER YUMA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ACTING AS THE ENTERPRISE ZONE ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, in 1990, the City Council supported the establishment of an Enterprise Zone; and,

WHEREAS, in 1994, the City Council supported the first five year renewal of the Enterprise Zone; and,

WHEREAS, in 1999, the City Council supported the second five year renewal of the Enterprise Zone; and,

WHEREAS, after five years, the Enterprise Zone terminates; and,

WHEREAS, there exists a new renewal procedure which requires an Intergovernmental Agreement to be entered into by the City of San Luis to show continued support of the same.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Luis, as follows:

Section 1. That the City of San Luis supports the renewal and continuation of the County-wide Enterprise Zone, with the Yuma County Board of Supervisors acting as the Enterprise Zone Commission and the Greater Yuma Economic Development Corporation acting as Enterprise Zone Administrator; and,

Section 2. That the City Administrator is authorized to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement, attached as exhibit A, with the City of San Luis, the City of Somerton, the Town of Wellton, and the County of Yuma to comply with the provisions of the Arizona Revised Statutes to apply for an Enterprise Zone designation renewal.
