RESOLUTION NO. 586

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE NEW COMMERCIAL PORT OF ENTRY AND ESTABLISHING DATES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF INFRASTRUCTURE

Whereas, the City of San Luis, Arizona has joined with the County of Yuma, Arizona, the City of Yuma, Arizona, and the Cocopah Tribe in forming the Greater Yuma Port Authority, Inc. for the purpose of the development of a new commercial port of entry to Mexico to be located in San Luis, Arizona;

Whereas, the City of San Luis, Arizona is a city of a population in excess of 20,000 with more than fifty percent unemployment;

Whereas the new proposed commercial port of entry is vital to the future economic growth of the City of San Luis and greater Yuma County;

Whereas the new proposed commercial port of entry will have positive impact on economic growth and prosperity for the State of Arizona;

Whereas, the proposed new commercial port of entry will mean an expansion of economic development in San Luis, Arizona including expansion in industrial and commercial development which will create new employment opportunities for the residents of the City of San Luis;

Whereas, the proposed new commercial port of entry will mean an expansion of the overall economy of the City of San Luis which will enhance and improve the City's ability to provide necessary services to the residents of the City of San Luis;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona as follows:

1. The Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona hereby fully support the development of a new commercial port of entry in San Luis, Arizona and fully support and endorse the efforts of the Greater Yuma Port Authority, Inc, in accomplishing that goal.

2. The Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona hereby urge all elected officials of the State of Arizona, including all members of the United States Senate and House of Representatives, to support the development of this new commercial port of entry as vital to the economy of the State of Arizona; Yuma County, Arizona; the City of San Luis, Arizona; the City of Yuma, Arizona; and the Cocopah Tribe.

3. The Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona hereby state that it is the intent of the City to develop water and wastewater infrastructure such that service to the new commercial port of entry will be available on or before January 1, 2007 and hereby instruct staff to take such acts and actions as may be necessary to bring about such development.


