RESOLUTION NO. 624

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA DECLARING INTENT THAT WATER AND WASTEWATER SERVICE BY THE CITY OF SAN LUIS WILL BE DEVELOPED, COMPLETED, AND AVAILABLE TO ANY DEVELOPMENT OF A DETENTION FACILITY PURSUANT TO THE REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE CITY OF SAN LUIS DETENTION PROJECT AND RATIFYING AND APPROVING THE REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS FOR A DETENTION PROJECT AND AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Whereas the City of San Luis, Arizona has previously issued a resolution declaring its support of the development of a private federal support and detention facility in the City limits of the City of San Luis; and

Whereas the City of San Luis, Arizona in furtherance of the development of such a facility has recently issued a Request for Qualifications for the development of a San Luis Detention Project; and

Whereas the provision of wastewater and water services to such a project will be critical to its development; and

Whereas it is in the best interests of the City of San Luis to promote economic development on the East Mesa area of the City and the development of infrastructure on the East Mesa is critical to future economic development of San Luis; and

Whereas as part of the aforementioned Request for Qualifications there was a request for qualifications for development of wastewater and water services described in said document as the Economic Development Project;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona that Request for Qualifications is hereby ratified and approved and that the City of San Luis intends to develop and intends to provide water and wastewater services to the proposed Detention Project and intends to have such services available prior to the completion of the development of any such Detention facility.


The City staff is hereby directed to take such steps as may be needed or necessary to cause the provision of such services in a timely manner.


