## **RESOLUTION NO. 630**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL AUTHORIZING STAFF TO DESIGNATE FUNDS RECEIVED FROM POLICE DEPARTMENT AUCTIONS OF IMPOUNDED AND ABANDONED VEHICLES AND IMPOUND FEES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO BE USED FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMUNITY SERVICES AND PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the City Of San Luis seeks and promotes community activities for crime prevention, education, and youth activities; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the City Of San Luis continuously searches for funding to support community and youth programs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City Of San Luis wishes to support community and youth activities of its police department; and

WHEREAS, the police department of the City Of San Luis regularly impounds vehicles during the course of their operations and some of those vehicles are abandoned by their owners creating revenue to the City Of San Luis in the form of auction sales and impound fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the San Luis City Council as follows:

Section 1. The City Of San Luis will segregate within the City treasury according to its practices and procedures, revenues from auction sales of impounded and abandoned vehicles and impound fees, and;

Section 2. The revenue raised from the police department auction sales of impound and abandoned vehicles and from impound fees will be used to purchase equipment and supplies for law enforcement community services and programs, and;

Section 3. Any fees or charges from outside vendors or agencies that the City may incur as a result of impounding vehicles or as a result of the auction sales of such vehicles, including but not limited to towing, would be returned to the City's general fund account according to established procedures and practices.


