RESOLUTION NO. 631

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA ACCEPTING THE RESPONSE FROM INNOVATIVE GOVERNMENT STRATEGIES AND DIRECTING STAFF TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS

Whereas the City of San Luis, Arizona issued a Request For Qualifications For A Design/Build/Finance/Operate And Development Agreement For A Proposed San Luis Regional Detention And Federal Support Facility With Possible Future Expansions; and

Whereas notice of said Request for Qualifications was duly and properly advertised; and

Whereas said Request for Qualifications was mailed to known providers of those services within the private detention facility industry; and

Whereas multiple requests for copies of the Request for Qualifications were made by providers of those services within the private detention facility industry and copies were delivered in response to those requests; and

Whereas the City received one responsive response to the Request for Qualifications by persons and firms represented by Innovative Government Strategies and a response from another provider determining that they are not interested in being involved in a project such as proposed by the Request for Qualifications at this time;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: That the City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona accepts the response as presented by persons and firms represented by Innovative Government Strategies and finds that other prospective persons or firms had a reasonable opportunity to respond to the Request for Qualifications.

Section 2: That the City staff is hereby directed to enter into negotiations with the responding persons and firms as represented by the response presented by Innovative Government Strategies in accordance with the Request For Qualifications For A Design/Build/Finance/Operate And Development Agreement For A Proposed San Luis Regional Detention And Federal Support Facility With Possible Future Expansions.

Section 3: No contract or contracts related to the response shall be deemed legally binding until specifically approved by the City Council of the City of San Luis and properly executed pursuant to the laws of the State of Arizona.


