RESOLUTION NO. 637

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA TO DESIGNATE A SITE FOR A STATUE IN HONOR OF CESAR CHAVEZ.

WHEREAS, Cesar Chavez, learned about justice or rather injustice early in his life;

WHEREAS, Cesar Chavez, founded the National Farm Workers Association, later to become the United Farm Workers;

WHEREAS, Cesar Chavez, for more than three decades led the first successful farm workers union in American History, achieving dignity, respect, fair wages, medical coverage, pension benefits;


WHEREAS, his motto in life "SI SE PUEDE" (it can be done) embodies the uncommon and invaluable legacy he left for the world's benefit;

WHEREAS, since his death, dozens of communities across the nation have renamed schools, parks, street, libraries and other public facilities;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis wish to recognize this American hero and his efforts.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis will provide a site for the statue of Cesar Chavez to be placed, which will be donated by Cesar Chavez Monument Committee.


