RESOLUTION NO. 669

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS,
ARIZONA, ADOPTING A NEW EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN; REPEALING
ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.**

WHEREAS, Arizona Revised Statutes Section 26-308.B provides that each incorporated, city of the state of Arizona shall establish and provide for emergency services within its jurisdiction in accordance with state emergency plans and program, and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis recognizes the need for providing a current plan designed to facilitate emergency response during periods of crisis, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Luis as follows:

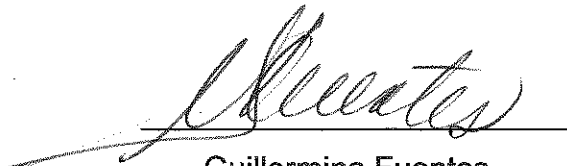
SECTION 1: That a certain document, three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of San Luis, being marked and entitled as the CITY OF SAN LUIS EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN, dated May 31, 2006, is by this resolution formally Adopted.

SECTION 2: In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Resolution and any other ordinance, resolution, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this resolution shall govern.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

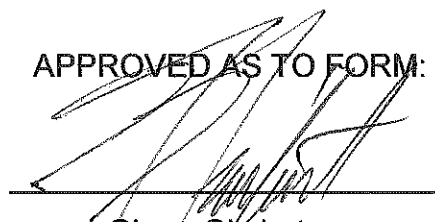

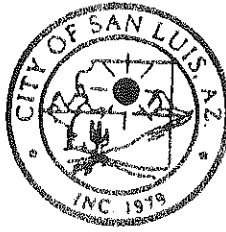

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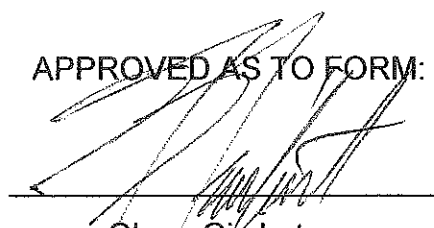
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
