A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA PERTAINING TO THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY'S FY 2006 STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROGRAM (SAFER):

WHEREAS, FEMA's SAFER Program is seeking proposals from state and local agencies for projects relating to FY 2006 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response Program (SAFER); and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, through the Fire Department, is interested in submitting projects to be considered for funding in the form of reimbursable grants from the Federal Emergency Management Agency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona as follows:

1. THAT approval of the submission of projects for consideration in FEMA's FY 2006 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response Program (SAFER) is granted.
2. THAT the City Administrator shall be the agent for the City of San Luis to conduct all negotiations and to execute and submit all documents and any other necessary or desirable instruments in connection with such grant.


