
WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, Arizona, is an Arizona Municipal Corporation;

WHEREAS, Cesar E. Chavez (1927-1993), civil rights activist and labor leader, has made a significant positive impact upon the residents of the City of San Luis and elsewhere; and

WHEREAS, Cesar E. Chavez was a native of Yuma County, Arizona, who had deep and long-standing ties to the City of San Luis and to many of its residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the San Luis Cultural Center shall henceforth be named the "San Luis Cesar E. Chavez Cultural Center."

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, this 13th day of September, 2006.




