## RESOLUTION NO. 691

### A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA ADOPTING THE YUMA COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN DATED DECEMBER 2005.

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Luis has historically experienced severe damage from natural and human-caused hazards such as flooding, wildfire, drought, thunderstorm/high winds, and hazardous materials incidents on many occasion in the past century, resulting in loss of property and life, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Luis Hazard Mitigation Plan (the Plan) has been developed after more than one year of research and work by the City of San Luis in association and cooperation with the Yuma County Multi-Jurisdictional Planning Team for the reduction of hazard risk to the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the Plan specifically addresses hazard mitigation strategies and plan maintenance procedures for the City of San Luis; and

**WHEREAS**, the Plan recommends several hazard mitigation actions/project that will provide mitigation for specific natural and human caused hazards that impact the City of San Luis, with the effect of protecting people and property from loss associated with those hazards; and

**WHEREAS**, the Plan is required by the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to be eligible for pre-disaster and post-disaster mitigation funds;


**BE IT THEREFORE**, that:

1. The City of San Luis Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as an official plan of the City of San Luis.
2. Future revisions and Plan maintenance required by the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and FEMA, will be presented to the City Council for adoption as their need arises.
3. An annual report on the progress of the implementation elements of the Plan shall be presented to the City Council by September 30<sup>th</sup> of each calendar year beginning in 2007.

4. The Plan shall be resubmitted to the Federal Emergency Management Agency every five years or as required.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the effective date of this resolution shall be the date approved and adopted.


