RESOLUTION NO. 885

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA,
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION AND EXECUTION OF A PARTICIPANT
AGREEMENT FOR ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT GRANT FUNDS
FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF JUAN SANCHEZ BOULEVARD FROM MAIN STREET (US 95) TO AVENUE
E-1/2 (SR 195)**

WHEREAS, the Land Use Goals, Objectives, and Policies of the City of San Luis General Plan (2001) include ensuring that the new commercial growth occurring to the east of the existing San Luis development area along Juan Sanchez Boulevard develops in accordance with the Land Use Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the Land Use Goals, Objectives, and Policies of the City of San Luis General Plan (2001) include requiring private developers to locate regionally oriented retail and service uses or other high-intensity employment uses along major roadways (e.g. Highway 95, Juan Sanchez Boulevard) with proper access, transitioning to lower intensity uses buffered adequately from residential uses; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation/Circulation Goals, Objectives, and Policies of the City of San Luis General Plan (2001) include working closely with federal, state, local, and regional funding entities to ensure transportation improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis Capital Improvement Plan 2009 includes the Widening of Juan Sanchez Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the U. S. General Services Administration (GSA) has completed construction of the San Luis Commercial Port of Entry (LPOE-2) to improve the secure transportation of goods between the United States, Mexico, and other trading partners; and

WHEREAS, the U. S. General Services Administration (GSA) proposes to renovate and expand the existing downtown San Luis Land Port of Entry (LPOE-1) to improve its functionality, capacity, and security; and

WHEREAS, procedures established by the Arizona Department of Transportation require the applicant to certify by Resolution the application, signature, authorization, and availability of local matching funds, and authorization to sign a participant agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Luis as follows:

SECTION 1: That the filing of an application for Transportation Enhancement Funds is hereby approved;

SECTION 2: That the application is certified to be consistent and compatible with all adopted plans and programs of the City of San Luis 2001 General Plan;

SECTION 3: That the City of San Luis agrees to comply with all appropriate procedures, guidelines, and requirements established by the Arizona Department of Transportation as part of the application process;


SECTION 4: that the City of San Luis certifies that it will comply with all appropriate State and Federal regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements as they relate to the application;

SECTION 5: That the City of San Luis certifies that it has matching funds of 5.7% not to exceed \$42,750 from the following sources: City of San Luis General Funds;


SECTION 6: That the City of San Luis commits to be ready for advertisement in three years from the date of execution of a contract: to pay for all cost overruns upon review and approval by the City Council; and to reimburse ADOT/FHWA for all Federal funds used, if the project is cancelled by the City prior to completion;

SECTION 7: That the City Administrator and designee is authorized to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, application, agreements, contracts, and amendments which may be necessary for the project.


