A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, REPEALING RESOLUTION 889 THAT WAS PASSED TO RELINQUISH THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS FRIENDSHIP PARK TO THE U.S. GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION FOR INCORPORATION INTO THE EXISTING LAND PORT OF ENTRY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona previously has passed Resolution No. 889 to cede to the federal government a parcel of land known as "Friendship Park" so that it can be incorporated into the existing land port of entry; and,


WHEREAS, the description of that parcel of land contained in Resolution 889 is in error; and

WHEREAS, other errors of fact are contained in the body of Resolution 889; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and City Council wish to make the transfer of Friendship Park to the federal authorities in a correct manner;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council hereby repeal Resolution 889.


